

ALBA-TCP REJECTS THE REMOVAL OF TELESUR' SIGNAL FROM THE DIGITAL TERRESTRIAL TELEVISION (DTT) CHANNEL LINEUP

The Member States of the Bolivarian Alliance for the Peoples of Our America – People's Trade Treaty (ALBA-TCP) reject the Argentine government's decision to remove Telesur signal from the Digital Terrestrial Television (DTT) channel lineup.

This action is an attack against the voice of the peoples of the world and undermines the right to inform and be informed. This decision illustrates the double standards of the Argentine government, who rhetorically boasts about the importance of freedom, while at the same time, he curtails the freedom of expression of millions of his own people.

Over the years, Telesur has become one of the most respected and widely used sources of information in the American continent and the entire world.
